Dear Parents and Guardians,

As Virginia moves into Phase II of Governor Northam's reopening plan, schools are now allowed to bring small groups of students in for in-person instruction including students in grades PreK-3, students with Special Education needs, and English Language Learners. Over the next few weeks, we will be reaching out to selected students to participate in these educational opportunities. In all situations, we will be adhering to social distancing guidelines and other practices to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and promote the safety of all staff and students. Campbell County Public Schools will develop a health plan in accordance with the Virginia Department of Health (VDH), and it will be posted on our website for community viewing before any instruction begins.

Secondary schools are also allowed to resume limited practices and conditioning for our athletes. A health plan will also be created and posted on our website to mitigate COVID-19 concerns. Each school will also have a plan in place that is team specific to protect our student athletes and coaches.

Our Reopening Task Force is in the process of creating our school reopening plan for the fall and we will keep you informed as that plan unfolds. Throughout this process we will work towards having in-person instruction as well providing a robust distance learning delivery of instruction to support the evolving situation, following the guidelines provided by the Virginia Department of Education, the Center for Disease Control, and the Virginia Department of Health. Our number one objective throughout this process is to return to a normal schedule as soon as possible while keeping everyone safe.
